However, here are several links which you can use to search for a good deal:

- <u>Airbnb</u> and <u>HomeAway</u> are both good options. If you aren't familiar with the area, contact us and we'll be happy to point you in the right direction.
- A low-cost option near the downtown area is the <u>Hostel Detroit</u>. This unique hotel features dorm-style rooms, shared bathrooms and kitchens.
- Hotel rooms in the nearby northeast suburbs of <u>Roseville, Sterling Heights</u>, and <u>Warren</u> are relatively close and offer reasonable rates.
- And you can always stay at one of the many <u>downtown hotels</u>, however be warned that prices are high for the convenience of being close to Belle Isle. (Also many hotels charge extra for overnight parking – make sure to ask.)

Some of our volunteers stay at the <u>Comfort Inn</u> on Jefferson Avenue, not 4-star, but very close to the Island.
